- A drive-away or tow-away transporter is a person engaged in the transporting of vehicles. These vehicles must be driven, towed, or transported singly, saddlemount, towbar, fullmount or any lawful combination.
- Only a Colorado resident engaged in the drive-away or tow-away transporter business may apply for transporter plates. A non-resident in this business in interstate commerce is not eligible.
- Each vehicle being transported must display a transporter plate. The plate must be affixed to the rear of the vehicle.
- Vehicles transported must be sold or be for sale and not owned by the transporter.
- Each transporter shall keep a written record of the vehicle(s) being transported. This record shall include vehicle description and name and address of the consignor and consignee. A copy of this record shall be carried in every vehicle. If vehicles are being transported in a convoy, all records may be carried in the lead vehicle.
- No transporter shall permit such plates to be used by any vehicle that is not in transit, or to be used by any other person, or upon any work or service vehicle, including service vehicles utilized regularly to haul vehicles.

I certify under penalty of perjury that the above facts are true and correct to the best of my knowledge; and that I am a Colorado resident doing business as a Drive-away or Tow-away Transporter and I am eligible for Transporter Plates and agree to abide by the rules and regulations relating to Transporter Plates.
