



MINIMUM VISION REQUIREMENTS

Minimum requirements may be met with or without corrective lenses.

NOTE: For Biotopic Telescopic Lens (BTL) vision requirements, see the Driver Licensing Information for Biotopic Lens Wearers form (MED44).

DRIVER'S LICENSES

VISUAL ACUITY 20/40 or better in one or both eyes

HORIZONTAL VISION 100 degrees or better

If you cannot meet the above requirements, you may be restricted to only daylight driving, provided you meet the following requirements:

VISUAL ACUITY 20/70 or better in one or both eyes

HORIZONTAL VISION 70 degrees or better -- one eye

If one eye only:
40 degrees or better temporal;
30 degrees or better nasal.

COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE

VISUAL ACUITY 20/40 or better in EACH eye

HORIZONTAL VISION 140 degrees or better

For persons with only one eye, the above requirements can be waived if you can meet the following requirements:

VISUAL ACUITY 20/40 or better in ONE eye

HORIZONTAL VISION 70 degrees or better -- one eye

If one eye only:
40 degrees or better temporal;
30 degrees or better nasal.
